

**FILI Policy**  
**Major's Annual Rifle Competition**

**Location:** Orientation at FILI – 210 Burgess St  
Competition: Crosse Creek Rifle and Pistol Club

**Time:** Orientation and Breakfast - 0900 hours  
Competition – 1000 hours

**Transportation:** POV

**Cost:** \$15 cash per participant

**Sign-up:**

Participants will assemble for breakfast and orientation at the armory at 0900. Orientation is mandatory. Participants will travel in personal vehicles to Crosse Creek Rifle and Pistol Club. Range setup and fire will commence as soon after 1000 as possible.

- Each participant will provide:
  - A small bore .22 cal. rim fire rifle with open iron or fire sights; weight will not exceed eight (8) pounds;
  - At least 50 rounds of .22 rimfire ammunition with additional ammunition to be used in sighting on the range;
  - Eye and ear protection;
- The rifle will be fired from a seated position.
- Appropriate rest or sandbags are allowable; rests that require the rifle be affixed will not be allowed.
- The butt of the weapon must be supported by the shooter's body.
- Participants sharing rifles will contact the range Officer in Charge (OIC) for placement in appropriate firing order.

Competition will consist of firing at 10 individual bullseye targets at 25 and 50 yards for a total of 20 recorded rounds. Competition rounds will not be coached. A short period prior to competition will be allotted for practice shooting and may be coached. Practice targets will be available at sign-up.

Scoring will be conducted by the Commander's designee.  
Winner will be awarded the blue hackle.
